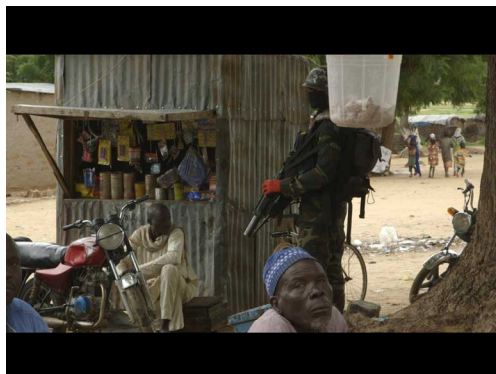




Le Spectre de Boko Haram
